The reporting platform is supplemented by resource hubs dedicated to staff, students and parents, and will help schools address the issues or concerns that may be raised through the reporting platform.



Safeguarding platform and resource hub for staff

Our aim is to create a one-stop shop for bullying support for school staff, students and parents. Including an Ofsted, SLT and governors live dashboard.
